Minutes for Providence Township Parks and Recreation meeting

Report from Vicki:

- Jim Grube will make the Sigman Road parking area a priority as soon as it dries out. It should take 2 or 3 days.
- The townships will be meeting to decide on standardized signage.
- Surveying is continuing.

Discussion continues on how best to stop parking on the west side of Fairview Road at the trailhead and to stop the access of buggies and vehicles on the east side of Sigman Road. Although gates and offset bollards were discussed, the ability for emergency vehicles to get on the trail is a top priority in any decision.

Greg reported that C.S. Davidson and Wilson Consulting have submitted proposals for the 222 bridge and servicing the other townships. He felt that there needs to be some clarification of the inclusions in each of the proposals.

A work detail is scheduled for April 4 at 8:00 AM. Volunteers are to meet at Fairview trailhead where the mulch will be spread. From there the team will move down the trail to places at bridge abutments and culverts where Jim Grube has asked for small trees to be cut down to prevent root encroachment.

A tentative work detail is planned for March 28 to begin marking the trail boundaries. More information will be posted as the decision is made.

There is no new information concerning planting of trees at Fairview Trailhead.
